Modalities adopted*	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Scrutiny has been done on the basis of the report generated by the computer system as per the information filled up by the candidates in their online application and the documents uploaded along with the same. 2) Post Graduation in Agricultural Economics has been considered relevant if statistics is also one of the subjects studied.. 3) Total experience claimed by the candidate has been taken into consideration, if supported by necessary certificates. 4) Only applications which indicate experience in the field of “Agriculture” or ‘Fisheries’ in the online application have been taken into consideration. 5) Teaching experience has not been considered relevant 6) Candidates whose experience is not in the relevant field as per RRs are rejected under LEQ-B. 7) Experience certificates are to be in prescribed proforma. However, wherever the applicants have no submitted experience certificate in prescribe proforma, their experience certificate have been considered on merit. But those who have mentioned any Annexure therein and did not submit the same have been rejected as “Incomplete”. 8) Appointment letters, office orders, resignation letters, pay certificates and the certificates attested by the candidates themselves or self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience. Such candidates have also been considered as lacking relevant experience and rejected under ‘Incomplete’. 9) Experience Certificates without clearly specifying the nature of duties have not been considered and rejected as ‘Incomplete’. Similarly, applicants who have claimed relevant experience but the EC attached in support of that is not for the entire duration claimed or do not support the claim made have been rejected.
