NOTIFICATION

G.S.R....(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of article 318 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Union Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1969,

- 1. These regulations may be called the Union Public Service Commission (Members) Amendment Regulations, 2009.
 - They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2005.
- In the Union Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1969, in regulation 8, in sub-regulation (2), the following provise shall be inserted, namely:

*Provided that for the period beginning on and after the 1st January, 2006 and ending at the 30th April, 2007 subject to rendering of a minimum service of three years as Chairman or combined service of three years as Chairman and Member, the retired non-official Chairman shall receive a pension at the rate of rupses forty three thousand sight hundred and ninety, for each completed year of service as Chairman in addition to Rupees thirty four thousand three hundred and fifty for each completed year of service as Member, together not exceeding Rupees five lakh forty thousand per annum and each of the other retired non-official Members subject to rendering of a minimum service of three years shall receive a pension at the rate of Rupees thirty four thousand three hundred and fifty for each completed year of service subject to a maximum of Rupees four lakh eighty thousand per

Provided further that for the period beginning on and after the 1st January, 2006, every retired non-official Chairman or Member shall be entitled to an additional quantum of pension with reference to their age in accordance with the following scale :-
