		<p><u>ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS (EQ):</u></p> <p>(A) EDUCATIONAL: A person shall not be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment to a duty post in Grade IV, unless he holds a Degree in Law of a recognized University or equivalent and unless he has been a member of a State Judicial Service for a period of not less than seven years or has held a superior post in the legal department of a State for a period of not less than seven years or a Central Government servant who has had experience in legal affairs for not less than seven years or possession of a Master's Degree in Law and has had teaching or research experience in Law for not less than five years, or is a qualified legal practitioner of not less than 30 years.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Note-I: Preference shall be given to a person with experience in legislative drafting.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Note-II: In computing the period during which a person has held any office in the State Judicial Service or in the Legal department of a State or under the Central Government, there shall be included any period during which he has held any of the other aforesaid offices or any period during which he has been a legal practitioner;</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Note-III: In computing the period during which a person has been a qualified legal practitioner, there shall be included any period during which he has hold any office in the State Judicial Service or has held a superior post in the legal department of a State or has been a Central Government servant having experience in legal affairs.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Note-IV: 'Qualified legal practitioner' means an advocate or a pleader who has practiced as such for at least seven years, or an attorney of the High Court of Bombay or Calcutta who has practiced as such for at least five years or has practiced as such attorney and an advocate for a total period of at least five years</p> <p>(B) EXPERIENCE: As mentioned in column A above.</p>
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Modalities adopted	<p>(i) Preliminary Scrutiny has been done on the basis of scrutiny report generated by the ORA System and the information furnished by the candidates in their online applications.</p> <p>(ii) The scrutiny of the applications has been done strictly as per the provisions of the Recruitment Rules for the post in question.</p> <p>(iii) Total experience claimed by the candidates has been taken into consideration, if supported by necessary certificates. The experience put in after attaining the LLB degree has been taken into account. The experience in teaching or research has only been taken into account only in respect of candidates with LLM degree in terms of RRs. In case of ‘Qualified legal practitioner’, the experience put in after attaining the LLB degree has been taken into account.</p> <p>(iv) The candidates who do not possess the relevant essential educational qualification have been rejected as “LEQ-A”. Like-wise, if experience is not in the relevant field as specified in Recruitment Rules and advertisement of the post or relevant experience is less than the required period, such candidates have been rejected under “LEQ-B”.</p> <p>(v) Experience possessed in the relevant fields specified in the advertisement, after obtaining/qualifying the essential Educational Qualification has been counted.</p> <p>(vi) Applications of the candidates who have not furnished their Experience Certificates or have furnished the Experience Certificates which do not specify the nature of duties have been rejected under the category of “Incomplete Applications”. However, the candidates who have submitted part relevant Experience Certificate have been shortlisted, subject to production (STP) of the complete EC. Similarly, the applications of the candidates who have neither produced the marksheet nor degree of Law have been rejected under the Category of “Incomplete Applications”.</p> <p>(vii) Appointment Letters, Office Orders, Resignation Letters, Relieving Orders, pay certificates and self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience.</p> <p>(viii) Experience certificates should be in prescribed proforma in terms of Commission’s circular No.F.8/84/2010-R(C&P) dated 23.12.2010. However, wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their experience certificates have been considered on merit.</p>
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Criteria adopted for short listing	<p>EQ-A + EQ-B raised to 15 years & 6 months.</p> <p>EQ-A + EQ-B raised to 13 years & 6 months (In respect of candidates with LLM & having exclusive experience in teaching or research only).</p>
