
- The scrutiny and shortlisting details of this recruitment case were initially uploaded on the official website of the Commission on 29.05.2024.



Modalities adopted	<p>(i) Scrutiny has been done online, first on the basis of the Scrutiny Report generated by the computer system as per the information filled up/claims made therein by the candidates in their Online Recruitment Application (ORA) form and thereafter by scrutiny of the supported documents/certificates uploaded with the ORA only in respect of candidates whose applications are prime-facie found eligible on the basis of information filled up/claims made by them in the online applications.</p> <p>(ii) Total experience claimed by the candidate has been taken into consideration if supported by necessary certificates.</p> <p>(iii) Scrutiny has been done strictly in accordance with the Essential Educational and desirable qualifications prescribed for the post and the conditions laid down in the advertisement of the post.</p> <p>(iv) Appointment letters, office orders, resignation letters, pay certificates, service certificates and the certificates attested by the candidates themselves or self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience. Such candidates have been rejected under 'Incomplete' category.</p> <p>(v) Experience acquired as Part time/hourly basis/daily wages/Apprentice/Trainee/Consultant/Honorary/Voluntary/Casual/Internship Period/Self-employment has not been counted while counting experience.
