(iv) Experience as an Assistant Professor etc. in Agricultural Extension/Extension Education has been considered relevant towards EQ-B. (v) Same experience claimed in the related fields of Agricultural Extension activities in Essential Qualification and Desirable Qualification columns in ORA have been considered for both i.e. Essential Qualification-B and Desirable Qualification.
