**ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS( EQs):**

**A.**

- i) A recognized Medical Qualification included in the First or the Second Schedule or Part-II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956). Holders of Educational Qualifications included in Part-II of the Third Schedule fulfill the conditions stipulated in Section 13 of the said Act.

ii)

A recognized Post Graduate Degree in Community Medicine with two years' experience in the field of Occupational Health, preferably in factories or mines.

OR

A recognized Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Health or Occupational Health or Public Health with three years' experience in the field of Occupational Health, preferably in factories or mines.

**The total numbers of effective applications is 27. All the applications have been considered.**

**1.** The scrutiny and short-listing details of this recruitment case were initially uploaded on the website of the Commission on 15.02.2024.

**2.** The candidates were given a window to express their concerns through email within 10 days.

3. Following short-listing criteria has been adopted to shortlist the candidates for interview:

EQA(i) & (ii)

5. Only two candidates bearing Roll Nos. **15** & **22** have sent their representation(s) alongwith supporting documents. The examination of these two representations are as follows:

S.No.	Reasons for Initial Rejection	Representation	Outcome
1.	Roll No. 15 (UR) Application not scrutinized by virtue of keeping 01-UR post vacant in lieu of the PH vacancy.	The candidate has claimed to be eligible as per the shortlisting criteria.	Application need not be scrutinized by virtue of keeping 01-UR post vacant in lieu of the PH vacancy. Hence, his rejection is maintained.
2.	Roll No. 22 (OBC) The candidate got rejected under LEQ-A(i) & (ii)	The candidate has sent the same documents with the representation as uploaded in the online application and has requested to reconsider her application for interview.	Candidate has 06 months' certificate course which has not been considered as post graduate diploma. Also the candidate has not claimed any experience in the relevant field after PG degree/diploma. Hence, his rejection is maintained.

**Shortlisting:**

No candidate has been shortlisted for the post.

Since the only application( Roll no. 03) received against 01-PH vacancy has not been found suitable, the recruitment action to fill up 01-PH vacancy has become infructuous at scrutiny stage. By virtue of 01-PH vacancy becoming infructuous, 01- UR vacancy has been kept

unfilled. Accordingly, applications of UR category have not been scrutinized.
