ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS(EQs):

(A) EDUCATIONAL:

(i) A recognized MBBS qualification included in the First or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II of the Third Schedule should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

(ii) Post-graduate Degree/Diploma in the concerned speciality mentioned in Section-A or Section B in Schedule VI or equivalent i.e., M.D. (Tuberculosis)/M.D. (TB & Respiratory Disc)/M.D.(Medicine) with T.D.D. /M.D.(Medicine) with D.T.D./M.D.(Medicine) with D.T.C.D./M.D.(TB & Chest Diseases)/T.D.D/D.T.D./D.T.C.D.

(B) EXPERIENCE:

Three years, experience in the concerned speciality after obtaining the first Post Graduate Degree or 5 years' experience after obtaining the Post Graduate Diploma.

Note 1: The Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualifications granted in United Kingdom shall be recognized medical qualifications only when granted on or before 11-11-1978.

The total numbers of effective applications is 28. All the applications have been considered.

Modalities:

- (1) Scrutiny has been done on the basis of the scrutiny report generated by the Computer System as per the information filled in by the candidates in the online application form and the documents certified uploaded with ORA.
- (2) Experience as part time/hourly basis/ daily wages/visiting/guest faculty/ consultant/ honorary/ self employed and stipendiary has not been counted while counting experience. However, experience on contract basis in relevant field and experience after obtaining MD/MS degree and while pursuing the higher degree has been considered for scrutiny.
- (3) Total experience claimed by the candidates in the relevant field has been taken into consideration. If supported by the necessary certificates.
- (4) OBC candidate having certificate from outside Delhi have been considered in UR category with raised criterion only.
- (5) PG degree in Pulmonary Medicine/Respiratory Disease awarded by few institutes has been considered at par with the PG degree in Tuberculosis and Respiratory Disease.

The following criteria has been adopted for short listing the candidates:

a. For 01 (UR) post :

EQ-A(i) +EQ-A(ii) + EQ-B raised by 04 years for PG degree and 06 years for PG Diploma.

1. In the advertisement, only 05 (OBC) applications were received against the 01(OBC) vacant post but none of them was holding OBC certificate issued by NCT of Delhi, therefore they were not considered against the OBC vacancy. However, one application (Roll No. **25**) was having more than 04 years of experience and has been considered under UR category only. Hence, the OBC vacancy for the aforesaid post has become **infructuous** at scrutiny stage.

2. The scrutiny and short-listing details of this recruitment case were uploaded on the website of the Commission on 25th June, 2024. Subsequently, the rejected candidates were given a window to express their concerns through email (sort1.upsc@nic.in) within 10 days till 05/07/2024. In response, only four candidates (Roll Nos. 02, 08, 15 & 17) responded against their rejection(s) and sent supporting documents/certificates in order to be shortlisted. The representations were examined as under:

1.	02, 08 & 17.	LEQ-B	After examination of the experience certificates/documents, the relevant experience counted for each candidate is less than the required one. Therefore, rejection shall be maintained.
2.	15	LEQ-B	The candidate did not send any supporting document. Therefore, rejection shall be maintained.
