ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

A) EDUCATIONAL:

- (i) A recognized MBBS degree
- (ii) PostGraduate degree/ Diploma in the concerned speciality or super speciality

(B) EXPERIENCE: At least three years' experience after obtaining the first Post Graduate degree or 5 years' experience after obtaining post graduate diploma.

The total numbers of effective applications is 33. All the applications have been considered.

1. The scrutiny and short-listing details of this recruitment case were initially uploaded on the website of the Commission on 01.12.2023.

2. The candidates were given a window to express their concerns through email within 10 days.

3. Following short-listing criteria has been adopted to shortlist the candidates for interview:

For UR/OBC posts:

Criterion: **EQ-A(i) + EQ-A(ii) + EQ-B**

For SC post:

Criterion: **EQ-A(i) + EQ-A(ii) + EQ-B relaxable upto 50%.**

4. Since some of the candidates had not uploaded complete documents while filling online application, 06 candidates bearing roll nos. 02, 14, 16, 20, 22 & 23 were provisionally shortlisted, who were asked to furnish copies of the deficient documents/relevant certificates. Out of these 06 candidates, only 03 candidates(Roll no. 02, 16 & 20) have responded & sent the deficient documents. Remaining 03 candidates (Roll no. 14, 22 & 23) who failed to submit the deficient documents have been rejected under "Incomplete application" category.

5. Two candidates bearing Roll Nos. **21** & **33** have sent their representation(s) alongwith supporting documents. The examination of these two representations is as under:
