Essential Qualifications	ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS: (A) EDUCATIONAL [EQ(A)]:- Masters Degree in Zoology from a recognized University (B) EXPERIENCE [EQ(B)]:- Three Years' experience in research and technique in the field of Zoology from the Central or State or Union territory Government/ Autonomous Body or Statutory Organizations or Public Sector Undertakings or University or Recognized Research Institutes.
Desirable Qualifications	Desirable Qualification (DQ):- Doctorate degree in Zoology from a recognized University or Institute.

Modalities adopted	<p>(i). Scrutiny has been done online, first on the basis of the report generated by the computer system as per the information filled up/claims made therein by the candidates in their online application and thereafter by scrutiny of the supporting documents uploaded along with the same only in respect of candidates whose applications are prima-facie found eligible on the basis of information filled up/ claims made by them in the online applications.</p> <p>(ii). The scrutiny of the applications has been done strictly as per the provisions of the Recruitment Rules for the post in question.</p> <p>(iii). Total experience claimed by the candidates has been taken into consideration, if supported by necessary certificates.</p> <p>(iv). If experience is not in the relevant field as specified in Recruitment Rules and advertisement of the post or the calculated relevant experience is less than the essential period as specified in the Recruitment Rules, such candidates have been rejected under "LEQ-B". Applicants who claim relevant experience but the EC attached in support of that do not support the claim made are also rejected as 'LEQ-B'.</p>
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(v). The candidates who do not possess the relevant essential educational qualification have been rejected as "LEQ-A". However, candidates having M. Sc. in Life Science Programme is considered relevant on account of University clarification regarding equivalency of Life Science Programme with M. Sc. Zoology/Botany.

(vi). Experience Certificate must be uploaded/ available to ascertain the eligibility of the candidates. Hence, applications of candidates who have not uploaded/ furnished experience certificate, have been rejected as "**Incomplete Application**". Experience Certificates without clearly specifying the nature of duties have also not been considered and rejected as '**Incomplete**'. Similarly, applicants who claim relevant experience but the EC attached in support of that is not of the entire duration claimed or do not support the claim made are also rejected as '**Incomplete**'.

(vii). The applications of the candidates who have neither produced the mark sheet nor degree of the essential educational qualifications have been rejected under the Category of "**Incomplete Applications**".

(viii). Teaching Experience has not been considered relevant.

(ix). Appointment Letters, Office Orders, Registration/Enrolment Certificate, Resignation Letters, Relieving Orders, pay certificates and self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience. Also, experience as 'Intern' has also not been treated as relevant experience.

(x). Experience certificates should be in prescribed proforma in terms of Commission's circular No. F.8/84/2010-R(C&P) dated 23.12.2010. However, wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their experience certificates have been considered if Experience Certificate otherwise satisfy the details of the prescribed Experience Certificate.

(xi). Some of the candidates can be rejected under more than one category. They have been rejected under the most appropriate category.

i) The scrutiny and shortlisting details of this recruitment case were initially uploaded on the official Website of the Commission on 03.04.2024.

ii) The candidates who were provisionally shortlisted for subject to the submission of requisite document(s), were requested to send their document(s) through e-mail by 13.04.2024. Also, candidates were given a window to express their concerns, if any, through e-mail till 13.04.2024. It was also mentioned that all the e-mails will be examined but no individual response to any such mails would be given as indicated earlier. It was further assured that the revised scrutiny and shortlisting details would be uploaded in due course.

(iii) Keeping in view of the scrutiny uploaded, 24 provisionally shortlisted candidates subject to submission of their requisite documents and based on the documents provided by the them, now 22 candidates have been shortlisted to be called for interview and 02 candidates have been rejected under "Incomplete" Category.

(iv) Further, 17 representations have been received and all the representations alongwith their online recruitment applications with reference to age, category, qualification, Experience and Desirable Qualification claimed in the Online Recruitment Application have been examined in view of the adopted shortlisting criteria and modalities approved by the Commission. After examination, rejection of applications of 08 candidates are found to be in order and it has been maintained. Applications of 09 candidates are not in the consideration zone.

(v) Accordingly, the final scrutiny of applications is as under:-

In response to the advertisement, 455 (SC-89, ST-12, OBC-103, Gen.-235 and EWS-16) applications, including applications of PwBDs, have been received. Applications belonging to ST category have been considered under unreserved category. Scrutiny has been done on the basis of the particulars furnished by the candidates online and the uploaded documents. By adopting the above mentioned criteria, 202 applications are covered under zone of consideration for scrutiny. Since, Enhanced experience has been invoked, remaining applications have not been considered and Roll numbers of applications which are not under consideration zone, have not been mentioned in this scrutiny details. However, final status of scrutiny details of 202 applications, which are covered under zone of consideration are as under:-



As none of the PwBD candidate has been found eligible against 01-PwBD vacancy, the recruitment action to fill up 01-PwBD vacancy has been treated as Infructuous at scrutiny stage. By virtue of 01-PwBD becoming infructuous, 01-UR vacancy has been kept unfilled.
