Such candidates have been rejected under 'Incomplete' category. • Experience Certificates without clearly specifying the nature of duties have not been considered and rejected as 'Incomplete'. Similarly, applicants who have claimed relevant experience but the EC attached in support of that is not for the entire duration claimed or do not support the claim made have been rejected. Only the time period of relevant experience, for which EC indicating the requisite/relevant experience have been considered. • Some of the candidates can be rejected under more than one category. They have been rejected under the category considered as most appropriate.
