ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS(EQs):

(A) EDUCATIONAL:

- (i) A recognized MBBS degree qualification included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, (102 of 1956). Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II of Third Schedule should also fulfil the conditions specified in subsection (3) of Section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956).
- (ii) Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in the concerned Speciality or Super-speciality mentioned in Section-A or Section-B in Schedule VI i.e., Doctor of Medicine (Obstetrics and Gynaecology) or Master of Surgery (Obstetrics and Gynaecology) or Diplomate National Board (Obstetrics and Gynaecology) or Diploma in Gynaecology and Obstetrics.

(B) EXPERIENCE:

Three years' experience in the concerned Speciality or super-speciality after obtaining the first Post-graduate degree or 5 years' experience after obtaining the Post-graduate Diploma.

Note-1: Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) or Magister Chirurgiae (M.Ch.) qualification of three years' duration shall be counted towards requirement of experience in the concerned broad speciality.

- **Note-2**: Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) or Magister Chirurgiae (M.Ch.) of five years' duration shall be taken as three years for completion of post graduate degree and the last two years of the said Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) or Magister Chirurgiae (M.Ch) shall be counted towards requirement of teaching experience.
- **Note-3**: The Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C. for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.
- **Note-4**: The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C., for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes if at any stage of selection the U.P.S.C. is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from the Community possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

The total numbers of effective applications is 65. All the applications have been considered.

Modalities:

- (i) PS has been done strictly in accordance with Essential Qualifications prescribed for the post and the conditions laid down in the advertisement for the post.
- (ii) Scrutiny has been done online, first on the basis of the report generated by the computer system as per the information filled up/claims made therein by the candidates in their online applications and thereafter by scrutiny of the supporting documents uploaded along with the same only in respect of candidates whose applications are prima–facie found eligible on the basis of information filled up/claims made by them in the online applications.
- (iii) The candidates who do not possess the relevant essential educational qualifications have been rejected as "LEQ-A". Likewise, if essential experience is not in the relevant field as specified, in the Recruitment Rules of the post or relevant experience is less than the required period; such candidates have been rejected under "LEQ-B".

- (iv) Experience acquired as Part Time/ hourly basis/ daily wages/ visiting/Guest faculty/ Apprentice/ trainee/Consultant/ Honorary/ Internship period/Self-employed and stipendiary has not been counted while counting experience. Experience on contract basis in the relevant filed has been considered.
- (v) Some of the candidates can be rejected under more than one category. They have been rejected under category considered as most appropriate.
- (vi) Experience certificates in prescribed proforma as per the advertisement have been considered. Wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their experience certificate have been considered on merit.
- (vii) Relaxation upto 50% has been proposed for filling up the post of SC.

The following criteria has been adopted for short listing candidates:

For **UR/OBC** posts:

Criterion: **EQ-A(i)** + **EQ-A(ii)** + **EQ-B**

For **SC posts:**

Criterion: EQ-A(i) + EQ-A(ii) + EQ-B Relaxable upto 50%.

- **1.** The scrutiny and short-listing details of this recruitment case were uploaded on the website of the Commission on 05th December, 2023. Subsequently, the candidates were given window to express their concerns through email within 10 days till 15/12/2023.
- 2. In the initially uploaded short listing criteria, there were 21 provisionally short-listed candidates. These candidates needed to submit deficient documents to be shortlisted for interview. Ten candidates (Roll Nos. 11, 19, 26, 28, 32, 40, 41, 42, 58 & 64) responded during this period. In this 09 candidates (Roll Nos. 11, 19, 26, 32, 40, 41, 42, 58 & 64) sent their requisite documents and considered to be shortlisted for interview. But one candidate (Roll No. 28) did not send the relevant document/certificate and got rejected.

The remaining **11** candidates did not respond and their candidature got rejected.

3. Two candidates (Roll No. **6** & **18**) have raised representations against their rejections and sent supporting documents/certificates in order to be shortlisted. Both representations were examined and considered to be shortlisted for interview.
