1. ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

A. EDUCATIONAL

(i) A recognized MBBS qualification included in the First or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II of the Third Schedule should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

(ii) Post-graduate Degree/Diploma in the concerned specialty mentioned in Section-A or Section-B in Schedule VI or equivalent i.e., Doctor of Medicine (Obstetrics & Gynae.) or Master of Surgery (Obstetrics & Gynae.) or Diploma in Gynecology and Obstetrics (D.G.O.).

B. EXPERIENCE

Three years' experience in the concerned specialty after obtaining the first Post-graduate Degree or 5 years' experience after obtaining the Post-graduate Diploma.

The total numbers of effective applications is 150. All the applications have been considered.

2. Modalities

(i) PS has been done on the basis of the Scrutiny Report generated by the Computer System as per the information filled in by the candidates in the Online Recruitment Application (ORA) form and the documents/certificate uploaded with the ORA, in respect of candidates whose applications are prima-facie found eligible on the basis of information filled up/claims made by them in the online applications.

(ii) PS has been done strictly in accordance with Essential Educational and Experience qualifications prescribed for the post and the conditions laid down in the advertisement for the post.

(iii) The candidates who do not possess the relevant essential Educational qualifications have been rejected as "**LEQ-A**" (Lacking Essential Qualification-Academic). Like-wise, if Essential Experience (EQ-B) is not in the relevant field as specified in the Recruitment Rules of the post or relevant experience is less than the required period; such candidates have been rejected under "**LEQ-B**" (Lacking Essential Qualification - Experience).

(iv) Documents uploaded like appointment letter, offer letter, resignation letter, transfer/ posting orders, office orders, self certification, affidavit etc are not considered as Experience Certificate and rejected under the category – **Incomplete**. Similarly, if the required essential document is not uploaded or the nature of duties are not specific in the Experience Certificate or the Experience Certificate is not matching the claim r if the Experience Certificate document is not acceptable; such cases are also rejected under-**Incomplete category**.

(v) Experience acquired as part time/ hourly basis/ daily wages/ visiting /Guest faculty/ Apprentice/ trainee/Consultant/ Honorary/ Internship period and Self-employed has not been counted while counting experience.

(vi) Some of the candidates can be rejected under **more than one category**. They have been rejected under category considered as most appropriate.

(vii) Experience certificates in prescribed profoma as per the advertisement have been considered. Wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their experience certificate have been considered on merit.

(viii) In the Advertisement, applicants were asked to upload all certificates/ documents along with Online Applications; however, some applicants have not uploaded complete certificates/documents. Those candidates who have claimed Essential Qualifications and fulfill short-listing criteria but have not uploaded relevant documents have been provisionally shortlisted and suggested to “**Call For Documents**” (CFD).

(ix) The posts for which no application has been received or no candidates could be shortlisted has been declared as “**Infructuous**” at scrutiny stage.

(x) OBC candidates who claimed Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) status, meet the Short-listing criteria, but not uploaded the OBC Non-Creamy Layer Certificate relevant to the recruitment year or uploaded old OBC-NCL certificates not relevant to the recruitment year, have been provisionally shortlisted and suggested to “**Call For Documents**” (CFD).

(xi) Reservation under OBC category will be provided only to those candidates who submit OBC certificate issued by Govt of NCT of Delhi. Candidates who submit OBC certificate issued by other states/UTs will be considered as General/Unreserved candidates.

3. In response to the Advt 01/24, a total 150 (UR-99, OBC-19, SC-20 & ST-12 including PwBD 01) candidates have applied online. However, some deficiency in documents of following candidates have been noticed & call for which is required to be provided by 10 July 2024. The summary is tabulated below:-

66/UR	LEQ(B)	The candidate has claimed experience from 16.01.20 to 07.02.23 ie 03 years & 22 days but not enclosed PG marks sheet with provisional Degree certificate. As per the criteria for UR candidate for the post, the candidates who have PG Diploma (Obstetrics & Gynaecology) are required to achieve 05 years experience, the claimed experience of the candidate is less than 05 years after completion of PG Diploma. The two years experience claimed during DNB training has not been counted as valid experience, hence rejection is maintained.

118 / OBC	OBC outside Delhi	The candidate has claimed OBC, but on examination of certificate, the candidate is enclosed OBC certificate from UP.	As the post is NCT Delhi and OBC candidate outside Delhi are considered as UR, hence candidate has been examined for UR post and accordingly recommended to call for interview under UR category.
122 / SC	LEQ(B)	The candidate has claimed experience 01 year , 06 months & 13 days.	As per the criteria for SC candidate for the post, the candidates who have PG Degree (Obstetrics & Gynaecology) are required to achieve three years experience and no relaxation has been given as sufficient candidates are shortlisted, the candidate has 01 year 06 months & 13 days experience, hence rejection is maintained.
