iii) Only the experience possessed in the relevant fields specified in the advertisement has been taken into account. Only applications unambiguously indicating experience in the field of credit system or payment and settlement system in Financial Sector has been considered.

iv) If experience is not in the relevant field as specified in requisition and advertisement of the post or the calculated relevant experience is less than the essential period as specified in the requisition, such candidates have been rejected under "LEQ-B".
