<b>Modalities adopted</b>	<p>(i) PS has been done online using Post Processing Software (PPS). First, on the basis of the information filled up/ claims made therein by the candidates in their online applications and thereafter by scrutiny of the supporting documents uploaded along with the same only in respect of candidates whose applications are prima-facie found eligible on the basis of information filled up/claims made by them in the online applications.</p> <p>(ii) Scrutiny in respect of essential educational qualification has been done in line with the indicative/illustrative list of subjects/papers under Cultural Anthropology provided by the Anthropological Survey of India, approved by Ministry of Culture.</p>

	<p>(iii) Total experience of the candidates as furnished in the online applications has been taken into consideration. Only the experience claimed in the Online Recruitment Application (ORA) have been considered as experience for scrutiny and certificates attached without its reference in the Experience column of the ORA have not been considered.</p> <p>(iv) Candidates whose experience is not in the relevant field as per RRs are rejected under <b>LEQ-B</b> category.</p> <p>(v) Experience of research claimed while pursuing M.Phil/Ph.D has been considered relevant only in cases where it has been indicated that Ph.D has been completed before the last date of submission of application or separate EC supporting the claim has been submitted.</p> <p>(vi) Experience certificates are to be in prescribed proforma in terms of R(C&amp;P)'s Circular No. F.8/84/2010-R (C&amp;P) dated 23.12.2010. However, wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their experience certificates have been considered on merit.</p> <p>(vii) Appointment letters, Office Orders, resignation letters, pay certificates, service certificates and the certificates attested by the candidates themselves or self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience. Such candidates have also been considered as lacking relevant experience but rejected under <b>'Incomplete'</b> category.</p> <p>(viii) Experience Certificates without clearly specifying the nature of duties have not been considered and rejected as <b>'Incomplete'</b>. Similarly, applicants who have claimed relevant experience but the EC attached in support of that is not for the entire duration claimed or do not support the claim made have been rejected. Only the time period of relevant experience, for which EC indicating the requisite/relevant experience have been considered.</p> <p>(ix) Some of the candidates can be rejected under more than one category. They have been rejected under the category considered as most appropriate.</p> <p>Note :- Modalities are decided by the Commission on case to case basis.</p>
