Modalities adopted	<p>i) Preliminary Scrutiny has been done on the basis of Scrutiny Report generated by the ORA System and the information furnished by the candidates in their online applications.</p> <p>(ii) Applications of candidates who do not possess the relevant essential educational qualification have been rejected as “LEQ-A”. Like-wise, if experience is not in the relevant field as specified in Recruitment Rules and advertisement of the post or experience is less than the experience enhanced as per Shortlisting Criteria, , such candidates have been rejected under “LEQ-B./BCA”. (Better Candidate Available), as the case may be.</p> <p>(iii) Experience Certificate is required to be uploaded/ available to ascertain the eligibility of the candidate.</p> <p>(iv) Appointment Letters, Office Orders, Resignation Letters, Relieving Orders, pay certificates and self-employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience.</p> <p>(v) Experience Certificates should be in the prescribed proforma in terms of Commission’s circular No.F.8/84/2010-R(C&amp;P) dated 23.12.2010. However, wherever the applicants have not submitted Experience Certificates in the prescribed proforma, their Experience Certificates have been considered on merit.</p> <p>(vi) As per the existing guidelines, candidates who have completed Ph.D Degree have been given 3 years credit towards research experience. Candidates who are doing ongoing research but have not yet completed Ph.D, their research experience is being counted for the number of years of research undertaken by them but restricted to maximum of 3 (Three) years only.</p> <p>(vii) Teaching Experience has not been considered as relevant. Experience as Lecturer, Assistant Professor etc., have not been counted as Relevant Experience for the purpose of shortlisting of candidates.</p> <p>(viii) Candidates working in PSUs have not been considered at par with the persons working in Central Government/UTs for the purpose of age relaxation.</p> <p>ix) As the number of applications received is very large, fixing a higher requirement in terms of experience for short-listing the candidates has been considered necessary. Therefore, the requisite experience in the relevant field as specified in the advertisement has been raised to 05 years.</p>
