ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS(EQs):

A. EDUCATION-

(i) A recognized MBBS degree qualification included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of Educational qualifications included in Part II of the Third Schedule should also fulfil the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

(ii) Post Graduate Degree/Diploma in the concerned speciality or super speciality mentioned in Section A or Section B in Schedule VI or equivalent i.e. M.D.(Pathology)/ Ph.D.(Pathology)/ D.Sc.(Pathology)/Diploma in Clinical Pathology(DCP) /Diploma in Pathology & Bacteriology(DPB).

(B) EXPERIENCE: Three years' experience in the concerned Specialty after obtaining the first Post Graduate degree or Five years' experience after obtaining the first Post Graduate diploma.

The total numbers of effective applications is 149. All the applications have been considered.

MODALITIES:

- (i) Scrutiny has been done on the basis of the report generated by the Computer System as per the information filled up/claims made therein by the candidates in their online recruitment applications.
- (ii) Experience acquired as Part time/ hourly basis/ daily wages/ visiting / Guest faculty/ Apprentice/ Trainee/ GET/ Consultant/ Honorary/ Self-employed and stipendiary has not been counted while counting experience. However experience on contract basis in the relevant field and experience after obtaining MD/MS degree and while pursuing the higher degree has been considered for scrutiny.
- (iii) Total Experience claimed by the candidates in the relevant field has been taken into consideration. If supported by the necessary certificates.
- (iv) OBC candidate having certificate from outside the Delhi have been considered in UR category with raised criterion for UR only.
