EWS certificate valid for 2023-24 has been considered relevant.</p> <p>(iii) Degree/Provisional certificate alongwith marksheet/final marksheet of a recognized University as mentioned in Advt. No. 12/2023, Vacancy No. 23061202624. has been recognized at par with a Bachelor's Degree in Aeronautical Engineering from an Indian University for purposes of recruitment to superior posts and services under the Central Government.(Copy enclosed).

Note: As per Public Notice of All India Council for Technical Education (Copy enclosed), MHRD, Govt. of India, through an order (vide OM No. 11-15/2011-AR (TS.II) dated 06.12.2012) withdrew the recognition granted to all certificates/qualifications awarded by professional bodies/institutions in the field of technical education. Accordingly, the Council decided to recognize equivalence for all purpose including Higher Education & Employment to Technical Courses conducted by various Professional Bodies/Institutions which were duly recognized by MHRD with permanent recognition upto 31.05.2013. Thus all those students who were enrolled with these institutions with permanent recognition upto 31.05.2013, stand recognized.

The Essential Qualification for the post is "A Degree in Aeronautical Engineering from a recognized University." Since in the EQ, there is no mention of equivalent Degree. Therefore, the candidates who have furnished the 'Section A & B of Associate Membership Examination from the Aeronautical Society of India' in support of their EQ, is not considered relevant for the post.
